

Fastbreak Basketball Club Coach Code of Conduct

All Fastbreak Coaches agree to:

- 1. Turn up to training sessions and matches on time, with the correct equipment.
- 2. Be appropriately qualified as per the requirements of the Basketball England Coach Education Programme.
- 3. Hold a clear Enhanced DBS check.
- 4. Ensure they have undergone relevant safeguarding training and submitted evidence to Basketball England.
- 5. Comply with all Fastbreak first aid policies and have up-to-date first aid training.
- 6. Communicate with other Fastbreak coaches and club staff in a prompt manner.
- 7. Follow guidance on good practice when working with young people/vulnerable adults and report any concerns for their wellbeing to the relevant authority.
- 8. Ensure that all training and playing demands are not detrimental to the well-being of the players and are reasonable, dependent upon the age, maturity, experience and ability of the players;
- 9. In Junior coaching sessions, the coach should not only refrain from initiating a relationship, but should also discourage any attempt by a player to initiate an intimate relationship.
- 10. Ensure their competence and ability is sufficient so that the safety or development of the players is not compromised.
- 11. Respect the rights of players to choose to decline to participate if they are injured or unfit.
- 12. Project a good personal appearance of cleanliness and never smoke in the coaching environment, or coach whilst under the influence of alcohol or any other intoxicating substance.
- 13. Never use foul, sexist or racist language or act in a violent/abusive manner.
- 14. Refrain from undue public criticism of other coaches or match officials.
- 15. Refrain from posting negative or derogatory comments on social media about other clubs, coaches or officials.
- 16. Refrain from posting any comments on social media which bring the reputation of Fastbreak into disrepute.
