

Fastbreak Basketball Club Junior Code of Conduct

When joining Fastbreak Basketball Club, all players must agree to the following.

- 1. Time Keeping
 - a. Players should arrive at the session/match at the time agreed with the club/coach.
 - b. If a player is going to be late, a parent/carer must communicate this with the coach as early as possible.
 - c. Players should wait outside the sports hall until the coach calls them in. Under no circumstances must the players enter the court and start warming up while another session is in progress. If this happens the coach will ask the player to leave the court and if this happens repeatedly it could lead to the player being expelled from the session permanently.
- 2. Conduct at training
 - a. Players should arrive in comfortable sports clothes with clean appropriate footwear (please ask your Coach for guidance if unsure) and a water bottle, if desired.
 - b. Players must always listen to their coach. It ensures everyone's safety, enjoyment and the best learning environment possible. If a player is proving disruptive to the session, they will be asked to sit at the side and in repeated cases, their parent/carer will be called to pick them up.
 - c. All members must respect their teammates, regardless of their age, disability, gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religious beliefs or political beliefs.
 - d. Do not use foul, sexist, racist language or rude gestures at any time.
 - e. Avoid violence and rough play and help injured opponents.
 - f. Welcome and include new players whatever their background or ability. Everyone was a beginner once!
- 3. Match conduct
 - a. Arrive in time for warm up and dressed appropriately.
 - b. Accept the decisions of the match officials without complaint (let your coach ask the questions)
 - c. Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
 - d. Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club. Breaking this rule can lead to permanent expulsion from the club.
 - e. Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance through the whole game, even if it is considered already over.
 - f. Be a good sport and thank your opponents at the end of the match.
