

Fastbreak Basketball Club Parent Code of Conduct

When registering their child with Fastbreak Basketball Club, all parents/carers must agree to the following:

- 1. General
 - a. Ensure your player arrives at training and matches at the set time.
 - b. Let your coach know via email or Whatsapp if your child will be late/not something to a session.
 - c. Wait with your child outside the hall until asked to come in, or with older children please make sure they know not to go in until they are called.
 - d. Please make prompt payment where required. Failure to do so will result in one reminder and after that the child will not be allowed to take part until payment is made.
 - e. Please make sure you read email correspondence from the club, especially before asking a question on Whatsapp.
- 2. Conduct at training
 - a. Please make sure your child is wearing appropriate clothing and footwear for indoor sport. Please speak to your coach if you need any help with this.
 - b. Teach your child to respect their teammates, regardless of their age, disability, gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religious beliefs or political beliefs.
 - c. Never force your child to take part in sport.
 - d. Remember that young people are involved in basketball for <u>their</u> enjoyment.
- 3. Conduct at matches
 - a. Encourage your child to recognise what was a good performance, not just the end result.
 - b. Set a good example by applauding good performances of all players.
 - c. Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
 - d. Recognise the value and importance of volunteers in basketball. They give their time, energy and resources to provide recreational activities for others. • Not shout abuse at officials, coaches, players or other spectators;
